You must receive your bobcat badge before you can be awarded rank. The requirements can be found on pages 16-35 in your Wolf book. (You may begin work on wolf requirements and electives before you receive the bobcat badge.)

This month's theme is ***Time In A Capsule***. Everyone will make a time capsule in our den meeting on September 27. Bring your items such as a photo, a sample of your school work, a note from your best friend or teacher, sample artwork, favorite toy, etc. to include in your capsule. Parents please write a special letter to your cub scout, you may want to include your hopes for what he will get out of scouting the next 4 years. The time capsule will be opened and the letter read at our final WeBeLoS ceremony just before he becomes a boy scout.

2. Complete all the arrow points in two of the following three electives Birds (pages 174-177), Grow Something (pages 184-187), or Fishing (pages 200-203).
3. Participate in a den or pack conservation project (den activity 9/20/04).

We will complete much of Achievement 7 at McKee park. We completed the fishing elective at our meeting at the lake. I have put together a bag that will help the boys complete the "Birds" elective. It includes a binoculars, a bird watching chart, a book about birds, and a guide to identifying birds. We will have a bird house workshop some time in October or November to complete the requirements.
